- F&B To Go Only!
- Clorox wipe down of carts, pens, doors, knobs and desk area.
- Single rider per cart. Disinfect. Maintain 6ft from others

- Cleaning properly, Food service is take out only

- Our on course F&B is open as well but on an honor system - social distancing. Skeleton staffing. Encouraging members to ride solo in a golf cart for the single rider golf cart fee - \$18
- Follow recommended policies
- Only to go food available
- Multiple sanitation practices for all touch points within the facility. Encouraging social distancing/ personal sanitation practices recommended by CDC & WHO.
- We're asking no one to arrive sooner than 15 minutes prior to their tee time. The cups are inverted, and all flags are to remain in the hole. No group is to stay and congregate about the clubhouse upon completion of play.
- Sanitizing carts, etc. wiping down doors, etc. No F&B , no water jugs, no ice.
- Not Open
- Social distancing Separate carts
- Constantly wiping all services; staff wearing gloves
- Closed
- Closed currently, discussing waiving march dues
- No rakes, single rider carts, hand sanitizer in golf shop and snack bar, frequent cleaning and sanitizing doors bathrooms, take out only for food service
- No practice facilities, no golf carts, no guests no staff on hand. Members may play golf in open play with no services.
- No staff. No services or use of Club carts. Members on their own to tee off at time of reservation.
- Following all health dept. recommendations including no physical contact with individuals, no group gatherings and wash your hands.
- Cart sanitizing, minimum contact, single cart
- We are only staying open for To-Go orders only.....
- Not open
- Doing msr hours online
- No buildings open. Private carts only. Recommendations to social distancing.
- special sanitizing sprays, social distancing, 1 rider per cart, every other range station open, etc
- Cups on the greens are raised an inch out of the hole so members will not be putting their hands in the hole or on the flag. One member per cart. Bottled water will be placed at locations out in the open so member will not have to touch anything to get a bottle.
- Cleaning best we can
- Tee times and credit cards over the phone. No interaction with customers. Pro shop and club house closed. Expecting to be totally closed tomorrow.
- Extra cleaning & wiping down equipment and carts. Canceled all large events until May.
- To go food only. Extra cleaning, and extra protection for staff.
- Closed
- No inside dining
- We can only offer "to go" items for pickup from the restaurant for lunch and dinner.
- Sanitize everything frequently
- No building access
- All buildings and services closed. Course open, no takes in bunkers, no carts of any type provided, club storage not available once clubs are used. Holes have one inch liner above the ground so ball doesn't go in the hole, flagsticks one cup but not to be touched . Bathrooms locked also on course
- No guests allowed. Lessons provided only on course , walking
- Clubhouse/Bar closed. Events postponed. Golfers may play but can't enter the clubhouse or pro shop. Increased sanitizing of carts, surfaces other areas. Social distancing.
- Constantly sanitizing all high use areas and equipment used by golfers. No on course water stations,

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- ball washers covered up, asking to leave the flag sticks in & allowing single riders if availability is ok.
- we are closed till april 7th 2020
- All commonly touched areas are being sanitizes and no touching of flagsticks. Single rider carts.
- Not open until April 7th
- No pairing up on carts Sanitizer stations Constant cleaning of touchable places Removed all things people can touch No shotguns Closed bar and offered Togo only Offered a market for members to buy necessities 6' distance from person to person
- Sanitizing regularly Golf Shop, Restaurant, golf carts. Remove rakes, water jug, covered ball washers.
- Prescribed by Tulare County
- Allowing single riders, encouraging gimmes inside putter length, sanitizing carts twice daily, bar window open for to go beverages, BBQ open outside. Everything sanitized frequently.
- Closed
- Not open
- The whole facility is closed, but of course members will sneak on to the golf course.
- Single riders, pull bunker rakes, lift cup, leave in flag, no more that two people in shop at one time, 6 ft between customers
- Sanitization and social distance
- We are closed
- Closed
- Closed for winter still
- Golf/tennis available for members and family ONLY. No guests are allowed at club until further noticed. Limited take out menu available from 4-7pm daily.
- We are trying to keep the golf option available by practicing social distancing and continuous cleaning! We feel providing any kind of normalcy is important today!
- Doubled our efforts in sanitizing areas public may come in contact with. Limiting areas of use inside the clubhouse. Given this is a fluid situation, operations are changing on a daily basis. Once information from local and state government become available, We're adjusting accordingly.
- Food and Beverage are to go orders only from 11am- 7pm daily
- no gathering in the clubhouse and To Go food only
- Golf Course: Golf Carts, sanitized in and out. Counter tops, door handles etc. sanitized Social distancing being practiced F&B: Snack bar and take out dinner only.
- Cleaning Schedule Updated for more frequent cleanings. Proving doors open at all times. Sanitize wipes available for all guests. All good is to go only. Check in is being done on an iPad outside of golf shop. Spacing tee times farther apart. Allowing single rider carts.
- Lots of sanitation supplies at the counter. Will know more on Friday. Haven't been there for a few days
- Carts unavailable, walking only. Golf shop closed with no staff inside or outside
- Members are allowed to walk however no staff available other than emergency staff.
- Take out food only for restaurant, wiping most things down hourly, single rider carts, disinfection carts after use., social distancing.
- Not open
- Takeout Only. Rakes removed from bunkers. 1 person per golf car. Flags to remain in cup at all times. Driving range closed.
- Play at own risk no club carts only walking and private carts
- Significant changes in safety protocol. Intensive cleaning of touched areas, single use carts, no rakes, keep flags in, snack bar "to-go", etc.
- 1" raised cups to prevent touching the Flagstick Removed rakes from bunkers Removed phone on hole 9 for food orders Members can ride single in a cart Steering wheels are consistently cleaned Offering delivery/takeout food orders
- Pay online or over the phone, no cash, one person to a cart or walk
- We have removed all ball washers, rakes, sand and seed bottles on course and that the flag stick stays in the hole to putt. cleaning and disinfecting carts upon finish and are limiting carts to person per cart unless family. mobile check in on patio to avoid gatherings inside the club house that is currently closed.
- Cleaning & Sanitizing everything after each use

IF OPEN, WHAT PRECAUTIONS ARE YOU CURRENTLY TAKING FOR YOUR STAFF?

- Clean everything
- 6 foot rule and hand washing
- Essential personnel only. No contact with things the public has contact with.
- closed
- Min. staff
- Hope and pray. Seriously: sanitizing at all opportunities, staggered work shifts
- Monitoring conditions and allow staff to make their own decisions on coming to work'
- Essential staff only, gloves, masks and sanitizer mandated
- Reducing labor, personal protective gear (gloves), minimizing touch points, promoting personal sanitation.
- No services are being offered
- Minimal hours with no overlap.

- Clubhouse is closed. Once members take their bag out of storage they will have to keep it with them. Outside staff will have to wear gloves when cleaning golf cars.
- Washing hands and sanitizer regurley

- One pro shop member per day, servicing the first tee and members through a window
- Closed
- Distancing. Sanitizing.
- Gloves, restrictions on lessons, asking anyone under the weather to stay home, not scheduling any senior staff to work. Asking them to constantly clean their work areas.
- we are closed
- Gloves, sanitizing supplies, social distancing
- Not open, supplying weekly meal with update on situation on site
- Hotel is open, employee dining room seating has moved to ball room for social distancing morning meeting is online golf course may open for members only to walk
- Constant cleaning of places that gets used by multiple staff members. The phone, counter, computers, door handles and time off if they choose to self quarantine.
- Rubber gloves. Workers 6 to 10 feet apart.
- See above along with CDC recommendations
- Requiring gloves, allowing to choose shifts, requiring frequent sanitizing, closed clubhouse for seating.

- Golf course staff is working. 6 foot distance between workers.
- We have some staff in to take care of the course and clubhouse. One of us will be in the shop if members call to bring their clubs home.
- Limited hours, go home if feel bad or uncomfortable with situation, increased sterilization of work areas

IF OPEN, WHAT PRECAUTIONS ARE YOU CURRENTLY TAKING FOR YOUR STAFF?

- Staff has been reduced to a core group of people.
- Social distancing
- no members allowed to stay in the Clubhouse; all gloved handlers of f&b.
- CDC postings & standards all communicated and staff training. We check each day with each employee on health status. Must stay home if they are not feeling well.
- Gloves during all transactions. Sanitizer available at all times. Encouraging customers to prepay or use credit cards instead of cash.
- Wiping down all surfaces with Clorox wipes
- work from home if possible, awareness at all times, wash hands, mainly managers working.
- Not open
- Latex gloves and masks provided during shift. Sanitizer and hand wash stations improved.
- Golf shop closed Food service closed with exception of take out
- Stay home if sick. Training on increased safety protocol.
- Gloves provided/mandatory consistently cleaning
- Discouraging customers from needing or wanting to enter the pro-shop, no more than two employees working at a time
- we have personal hand sanitizer and cleaning everything touched after each use.
- Limited staff for less interaction, space awareness and cleaning and sanitizing everything
