To create your new profile, log into PGA.org, go to your dashboard and then scroll all the way down to the section on Job Preferences. Please take a few short minutes to complete this job preference profile. There are only these questions to answer-

- Where are you in your search?
- Where would you like to work?
- What type of job are you seeking?
- What is your minimum salary requirement?
- Other preferences? (Seasonal/year-round)

Once you have entered your Job Preferences, the system creates a profile for you that matches open positions to your preferences. And every time you log into PGA.com, a list of jobs will pop up if any are open that meet your preferences.

Or you can search for any job that is on the Board. Again, log into PGA.org and click on Jobs. You can filter by title in the search bar or by Section or location on the left-hand side.
