

# NCPGA ANNUAL MEETING December 9, 2019 Green Valley Country Club – Fairfield, Calif.

#### I. Welcome & Opening Remarks

- a) Executive Director Len Dumas quieted the room for PGA Year in Review video.
- **b)** Dumas invited President Moriarty to the podium to officially call the meeting to order.
- c) President Moriarty welcomed the membership and reviewed the day's agenda.
- d) Moriarty thanked Presenting Partner EZ-GO and Care by Design, Supporting Partners Andy Paisal Golf Sales, Orange Whip, Pro Tag, Signs by the Sea, and NFP Hole-In-One USA, and long standing affiliate partner NCGRA.

- a) President Moriarty commented on memorable events in 2019, and encouraged members to get engaged with activities in 2020, namely the PGA Championship at TPC Harding Park. She wants Section members to strive to be "the best of the 41."
- b) President Moriarty recapped the two Resolutions passed at the PGA Annual Meeting.

## VI. District 11 Report – Bill Troyanoski, PGA

a) Director Troyanoski summarized 2019 activities and efforts by PGA of America to continue to improve benefits and representation for PGA members. He reported on two Resolutions that passed at the Annual Meeting, the change to the PGA Professional logo, the excellent condition of the PGA Golf Club, and the upcoming move to Frisco, Texas. He thanked the membership for the opportunity to serve as D11 representative.

## VII. 2020 PGA Championship: Barry Deach

- a) President Moriarty introduced Barry Deach, Championship Director for the 2020 PGA to be held at TPC Harding Park GC. Deach shared plans as they begin organizing for this historic event coming to the Northern California PGA Section. A video was shown depicting a simulated aerial view of what TPC Harding Park will look like in its transformation and build-outs for the 2020 Championship.
- b) Barry Deach introduced Dan Dillon, General Chairman for the 2020 PGA. Dillon expressed his excitement to host a TOUR event in San Francisco. He encouraged members to get involved, to use the event as an opportunity for a once in a lifetime experience for club members and community businesses.

#### IX. Employment Consultant Report – Carol Pence, PGA

#### X. NCPGA Foundation: Tim Burr, PGA

a) After viewing a video about the PGA HOPE National Golf & Wellness Week at Congressional Country Club, NCPGA Foundation President Tim Burr introduced veteran and PGA HOPE Ambassador Will Stockholm. Burr updated the membership on the success of PGA HOPE in Northern California in serving 1,000 veterans. He introduced the PGA HOPE Instructors and presented them with a gift. He recognized winners of the 2019 Chris Thomas PGA Associate Scholarship: Marc Jensen, Corey Hobbs, and Patrick Steiner. He acknowledged Greg Fitzgerald's Latinx golf program as a recipient of a Member Grant. President Burr encouraged members and associates to apply for funding from these available Foundation programs in 2020.

#### XI. Special Awards Recognition – Honorary Member Frank LaRosa for Mike Galli, PGA

- a) LaRosa provided overview of Special Awards Ceremony held on December 8, 2019 at Green Valley CC; highlighting the selection process and encouraging the membership to submit nominations as the 2020 Award Nomination process opens in January 2020.
- **b)** Award recipients were invited onstage to address the membership, ending with 2019 NCPGA Golf Professional of the Year Eric Lippert.

## XII. Board of Directors Election Results – Eric Lippert, PGA

- a) Lippert invited Bob Young to join him onstage where he was sworn in as the new Honorary President due to the resignation of Mike Mazzaferri.
- **b)** President Moriarty called the following outgoing Directors to the stage for recognition: Shawn Kelly, Nick Bailey, and Tim Sands. Each were presented with a service plaque.
- c) Honorary President Young provided a summary of the voting results:
  - i. 703 NCPGA Professionals are eligible to vote (905 total members).
  - ii. 185 voters cast a total of 498 ballots this election (3 Director positions).
    - 1. Directors-Elect (3 year term): Nick Bailey, John Hughes, and Tim Sands
    - 2. D11 Director (through end of term): Bill Troyanoski
    - 3. New Chapter President (2 year term) AJ Musser, North State Chapter
- **d)** Young invited all the Directors-Elect to join him onstage where they were sworn in for their appropriate term.
